Org. Setting and Reporting:

This individual contractor position is located within the United Nations Investigative Team to promote accountability for crimes committed by Da'esh / ISIL (UNITAD) and will be based in Baghdad, Iraq.

UNITAD was established by the Secretary-General pursuant to Security Council resolution 2379 (2017), according to which it is mandated to support domestic efforts to hold ISIL (Da'esh) accountable by collecting, preserving and storing evidence in Iraq of acts that may amount to war crimes, crimes against humanity and genocide committed by the terrorist group ISIL (Da'esh) in Iraq.

Responsibilities:

Under the direct supervision of the Associate Administrative Officer, the incumbent will be responsible for the following duties:

- Design all electrical systems including power, lighting, extra low voltage systems in accordance with project design criteria/requirements, specifications and applicable codes.
- Prepare all systems' details such as schematics, calculations, schedules and connections details
- Develop scope of work and technical specifications for all electrical-related works.
- Interact with other disciplines for interface requirements.
- Oversee electrical-related works during project implementation making sure that the works are implemented strictly in accordance with the SOWs/Specifications and other related contract documents.
- Perform other related duties as required.

Competencies:

Professionalism: Shows pride in work and in achievements; demonstrates professional competence and mastery of subject matter; is conscientious and efficient in meeting commitments, observing deadlines and achieving results; is motivated by professional rather than personal concerns; shows persistence when faced with difficult problems or challenges; remains calm in stressful situations. Takes responsibility for incorporating gender perspectives and ensuring the equal participation of women and men in all areas of work.

Planning & Organizing: Develops clear goals that are consistent with agreed strategies; identifies priority activities and assignments; adjusts priorities as required; allocates appropriate amount of time and resources for completing work; foresees risk and allows for contingencies when planning; monitors and adjusts plans and actions as necessary, uses time efficiently.

Teamwork: Good interpersonal skills; ability to work in multi-cultural, multi-ethnic environment with sensitivity and respect for diversity.

High school degree or equivalent education is required.

Work Experience:

Minimum of five years of work experience in a related field.

English and French are the working languages of the United Nations Secretariat. For the position advertised, good knowledge of the national language (Arabic) is required. Good knowledge in English is desirable.

Assessment Method:

Evaluation of qualified candidates may include an assessment exercise which may be followed by competency-based interview.
